


Campus

From a rented small school building, the university is now being run in three separate campuses (one of them is Gandhi Bhawan on the own land housing eight teaching departments) in the city of **Motihari**

University has acquired 135 acres of land out of 302 acres allocated.

15-20 Teaching Departments


Faculty

Out of **140 sanctioned** teaching positions, **121 regular** teachers have been appointed

From 259 in 2016-17, the university has now around one thousand bonafide students.






Publications
