A Fullbright fellow and reputed academician, Dr Venkat is known for his extensive research in the field of "Digital Passageways: Of Critical Humanities". In his lecture, Prof Venkat will draw the attention to the immensely diverse field of cultural and literary studies often ignored by Indian researchers. It includes the study of what he calls 'mnemocultures' or 'cultures of memory', passed on from generation to generation not through archiving or scripting, but through the acts of performance. His lecture will be helpful for any researcher curious in the study of myriad cultural forms of India. It will be of specific interest to the students of humanities and social sciences.
